KBSFC Inc. Bylaws

1. All Life Member fees will be paid for by the club. This does not include other family members.
2. All members must be financial before their scores can be counted towards any competitions. This also includes fish weighed in for Master's Awards.
3. Sub-Juniors only who fish with the club will be allowed a minimum line class of 3kg for club outing scoring purposes. They may fish lower line classes but they will have to divide their scoring formula by the 3kg line class.
4. This does not discount them from the Queensland Top Ten scores, National Records, Masters Awards State Competitions or when actual line classes may be used.
5. The Keppel Bay S.F.C will conduct 12 club competition outings on nominated dates throughout the fiscal year (July 1 to June 30). Club Championship scores will be determined on an anglers nominated best twelve (12) outings.
6. All fish weighed in for club outing scores must be weighed on club scales.
7. Only fish caught at the designated outing location on designated outing dates may count towards club scores. These fish must be weighed in at the club's nominated weigh-in point on the days and times nominated.
8. These fish can be weighed in by an Anglers nominated proxy if they cannot attend the weigh-in, however non attendance will be subject to review by a three person dispute committee.
9. Club Record Charts shall be established and maintained. These records are to be made, available to all members.
10. The minimum size for Beach Salmon has been raised to 30cm, this applies to Club Competition Only.
11. Female Fishers may nominate to fish B Grade if they so wish forfeiting all rights to the Female Champion Trophy and must do so prior to the first competition of the year.
12. The ANSA Length to Weight chart data may be used for fish which have been released to score points for an outing. Only fish listed on the KBSFC length to weight species chart can be used for this method.
