### **Sportfishing Tackle**

- Pre-test line, as either main or breakaway line, of the following line classes:  
     Light – 1kg, 2kg, 3kg  
     Standard – 4kg, 6kg, 8kg, 10kg, 15kg, 24kg, 37kg, 60kg

### **All-Tackle**

- No line class required i.e. braid, gel spun or heavy line classes.
- Equipment must conform to ANSA requirements
- Fish must be an ANSA eligible species
- Points will be awarded based on length and fish can be kept or released.
- All other club rules apply and fish scored in this category will be included in the maximum number of fish (5) allowed to be included on the score sheet in a competition.

### **Freshwater**

- For freshwater caught fish, points are allocated to the estuary category and where such fish are not listed on the ANSA length to weight chart the follow formula is used:

Points = 180 / line class (kg). (Note: If no legal length – ineligible)

### **Caught and released fish**

- KBSFC In By-law 12 provides the following:  
     “The ANSA Length to Weight chart data may be used for fish which have been released to score points for an outing. Only fish listed on the KBSFC length to weight species chart can be used for this method.”
- Where an eligible species is caught and is outside the range for the ANSA chart data, the weight is calculated by extrapolation of the trend of weight versus length for that species.

### **Beaches**

- For all fish caught from the beach, points are allocated to the estuary category.

### **Fishing times**

- Fishing times are from midnight Friday to 3pm Sunday.
- All fish must be presented at the weigh-in location by 4pm on Sunday to be eligible.
- Alternatively for members who are unable to make the weigh-in and do not require fish to be weighed in (e.g. fish caught on all-tackle or caught and released fish) must advise the recorder by 4pm on Sunday of capture details (e.g. location, type of fish, fish length and line class).
